School Van

A School Van operates from Raglan to Waitetuna School and back, on a daily basis. Cost is \$150 per student per year with discounts two or more children in the same family.





We offer targeted learning for individual students as well as the Steps 2 Literacy programme and Mathematics.

The school provides an Inter-School Cross Country, a whole school Triathlon and an Agricultural Day. Sports include football, netball, rugby, Ki-o-rahi, athletics, swimming. In addition there is an annual Senior Adventure Camp and Ski Trips. A Bi-annual professional School Production alternates with a Kapahaka festival.

We offer student leadership team initiatives & an inquiry based learning approach with digital fluency. Students enjoy reciprocal learning with Tuakana/Teina school wide.
